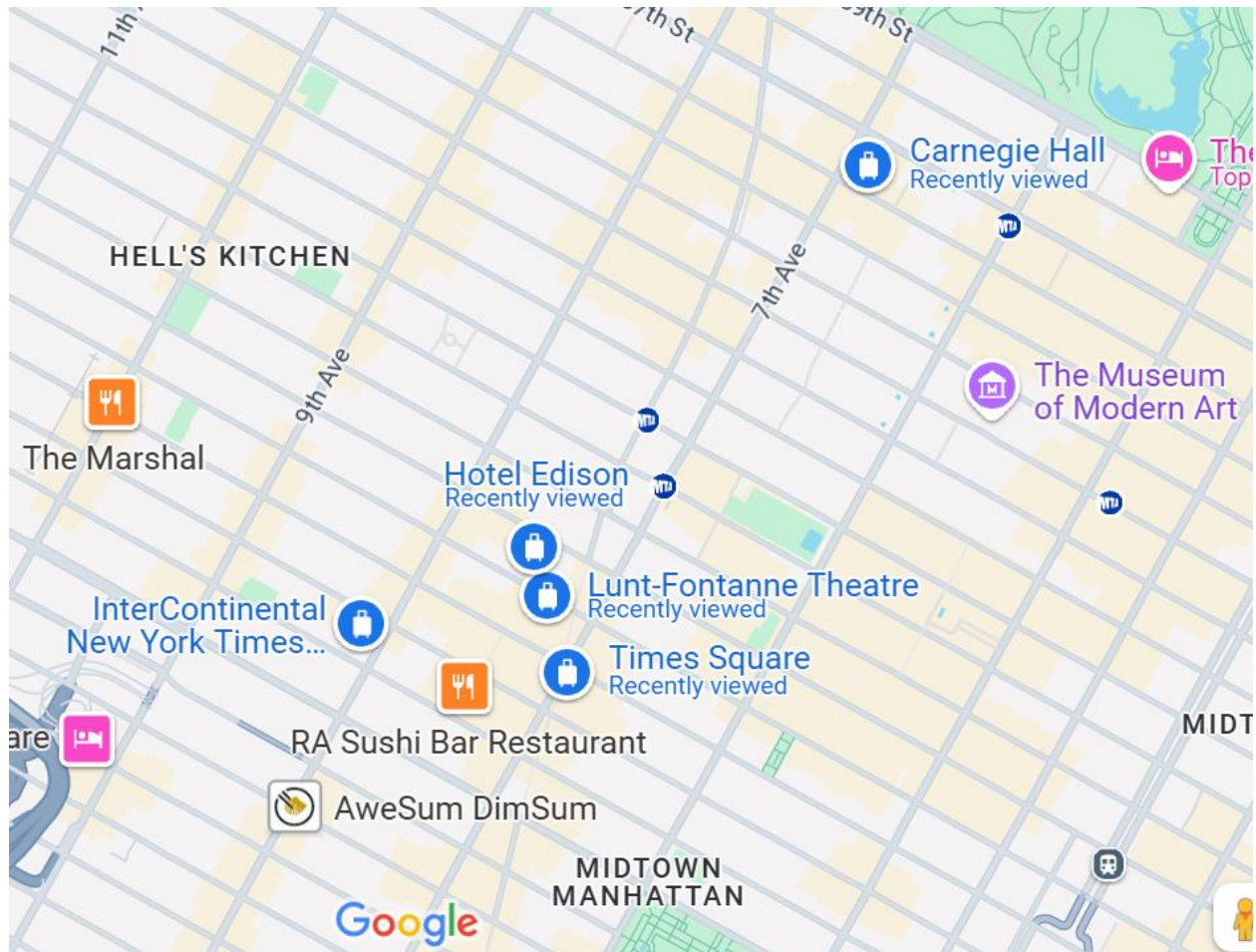

Walking Tour #1 – Times Square to 5th Ave (1.5 hours)

Time Square history and introduction. Lots to see and talk about there. Next walk to Rockefeller Center, Radio City Music Hall, see 5th Ave and St Patrick's Cathedral, maybe more of 5th Ave, see the Diamond District, and NY Public Library.

Walking Tour #2 – Midtown Manhattan (1.5 hours)(Subway)

See Hudson Yards and a small part of the High Line. Walk (10 minutes) to Madison Square Garden, continue walking to see Macy's (and the beginning of Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade), see the Fashion District / Garment District, and walk up Broadway from Herald Square finishing at 42nd Street / Times Square.

Walking Tour #3 - Greenwich Village (2 hours)(Subway)

We can take the Subway from Times Square (or wherever) to and from The Village. That's \$5.80 round trip. In the Village Dennis will cover Washington Square Park, the nightclub history with The Comedy Cellar, Cafe Wha, Bleeker Street, W 4th Street Courts (famous for street basketball), The Electric Lady Studio (Jimi Hendrix recording studio), maybe Stonewall, or if we go to the East Village the former CBGB's and former Fillmore East.
